REDEDICATION OF ENGLAND TO OUR LADY

As a preparation for the rededication of the country to Our Lady in February, The Angelus is recommended to us. Traditionally it was prayed at 6.00 am, 12 noon and 6.00 pm. It can help to break up the day with short periods of prayer.

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.

R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary, full of grace, etc.

V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

R. Be it done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary, etc.

V. And the Word was made Flesh.

R. And dwelt among us. Hail Mary, etc.

V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Let us pray.

Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts, that we to whom the Incarnation of Christ Thy Son was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ Our Lord, Amen.


Preparation begins 21st February with 33 days of prayer and consecration to Our Lady. The rededication is to be on Sunday, 29th March.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. JOHN BOSCO — FRIDAY, JANUARY 31ST

John Bosco - known as Don Bosco (1851-1888), was an Italian Roman Catholic priest, an educator and writer. Working in Turin, he dedicated his life to educating street children, delinquents, and other young people.

He developed teaching methods based on love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the Salesian Preventive System.

A follower of the spirituality and philosophy of Francis de Sales, Don Bosco was an ardent devotee of Mary, Mother of Jesus, under the title Mary Help of Christians. He dedicated his works to St Francis De Sales when he founded



the Salesians of Don Bosco. Together with St Maria Domenica Mazzarello (canonised lune 1951), he founded the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, a religious congregation of nuns dedicated to the care and education of poor girls.

In April 1869, after the construction of the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians in Turin, Don Bosco established the Association of Mary Help of Christians (ADMA) for lay people to follow the spirituality and the mission of the Salesians and to promote the veneration of the Most Holy Sacrament and Mary Help of Christians.
