On 17 November, his Holiness Pope Benedict appointed Mgr Terence Patrick Draine as the 7th Bishop of Middlesbrough and will receive Episcopal Ordination on 25 January at 12 noon at the Cathedral. We warmly welcome our new Chief Shepherd.

Mgr Terence Patrick Draine was born in Manchester 01/08/49 and ordained for the Diocese of Salford in 1975. He worked for 10 years as an Assistant Priest. In 1986 he was loaned to Kenya until 1991 when he became a Parish Priest back in Salford. In 1997 he was appointed Spiritual Director of the English College, Valladolid and became President of Ushaw College in 1993.
