## POINT TO PONDER

The Church, which takes us in at baptism like a mother does her child, accompanies on the last journey every Christian who has not explicitly refused the holy sacraments. **A funeral service is not an exaltation of the deceased. It is not a kind of beatification.** It is the prayer that the Christian community addresses to God to ask him to welcome in his mercy he who has ended his earthly journey and presents himself to him." Archbishop Of Modena, Benito Cocchi, preaching at the funeral last week of Luciano Pavarotti.

He tees up, takes an almighty swing and squints down the fairway. He turns to the brother-in-law. "Did you see the ball?" "Of course I did!" "Where did it go?" says Ben **"I can't remember"**.
