BISHOP AUGUSTINE HARRIS R.I.P

Bishop Harris, who died this week aged 89, was a priest for over 65 years and a bishop for more than 40. He served as a curate in two parishes and then as a prison chaplain, eventually becoming the Principal Roman Catholic Chaplain to Prisons. He was consecrated bishop in 1966 for the archdiocese of Liverpool and served two archbishops before transferring to our own diocese in 1978. During his 14 years at the helm he carried out a major re-organisation of Catholic schools and established four pastoral centres. He also saw through the building and solemn opening of our fine cathedral. He was a bishop with national responsibilities and served as episcopal liaison between the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales and the Prison Department at the Home Office.

Details of the Funeral arrangements:

There will be a reception into St Mary's Cathedral at 7 pm on Tuesday 11 September. The Cathedral will remain open until 9 pm. The concelebrated Requiem will take place the following day (12th) at 12 noon at the Cathedral. Following the Mass Bishop Harris' burial will be in the Cathedral vault.
